**Initial Screen**

- The Initial Screen is a questionnaire used to determine if a potential participant meets the target population criteria.
- The screen must be completed prenatally or within the first 2 weeks of birth by the referring agency to be sent to Healthy Families along with the signed Request to Contact form. *Anyone can refer, including the parent themselves.*
- Healthy Families contacts the family to schedule the in-person Parent Survey. *Surveys are currently conducted by telephone due to COVID-19.*

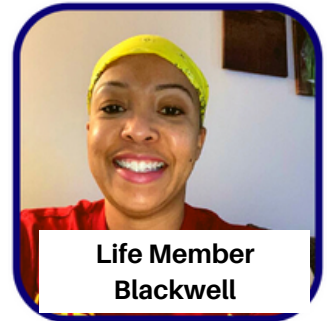

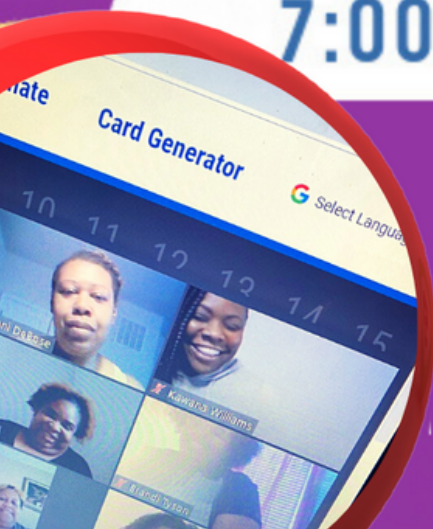

# Mi World Prematurity Awareness Day

## Marleigh's Story

On August 15, 2009, I was planning to attend an event when my sorors called and said I needed a doctor's note permitting me to attend. I laughed I was supposed to be home on bed rest. My feet were swollen, and my blood pressure was high. I didn't want to stay home any longer but rolled over and didn't feel well. I remember saying to my brother, I'm not feeling well. He immediately drove me to urgent care. At urgent care, they determined it would be best for me to go to the hospital. By Tuesday, August 18th, I thought I would be treated and sent home. My wonderful OB-GYN said no, she was in distress and would be on her way now. I was so scared, not for me but for my baby. I remember the very cold feeling of being prepped for the C-section. I remember praying she would be OK.

She was born 7 weeks early at 4 1/4lbs. She could barely nurse or cry. The doctor told me she was born with water on brain. They discharged me and kept her in the NICU. She did not have a crib, clothes, diapers, or food. Friends, family, sorors, and colleagues came together in record time to make sure we had everything she would need when she came home and beyond. During the three weeks she was in the NICU, I met families of other preemies who were much smaller than her. I met a mom doing "kangaroo care" for 2lbs preemie. I met the most fantastic healthcare workers who taught me how to take care of my beautiful newborn. Today, she is my beautiful middle schooler doing everything young ladies do. I am eternally grateful to all of the healthcare workers who do challenging work on behalf our children.

## I am a *Survivor*

At the beginning of February 2019 I noticed what felt like a hard bruise on my right breast. A few days later I had what I call a burning/numbing pain in that same breast. I went to the doctor who sent me for a sonogram and another mammogram. The doctor definitely saw a mass so they sent me to have a biopsy two days after my birthday. Within four days I was diagnosed with breast cancer and sent to a specialist. There is no history of breast cancer in my family. The specialist told me that because I knew my body and did my annual mammograms they could tell that the cancer was aggressive and needed immediate attention.

I have had a lumpectomy followed by chemotherapy and radiation. This month (October 2020) I will be celebrating one year since my last chemotherapy treatment and in December 2020 I will be celebrating my one year since finishing radiation treatments. So far my tests and follow ups have been cancer free.

I am sharing my story because if one soror can learn from my experience, it helps. Breast cancer is one of the most challenging things I have had to deal with in my life. Cancer affects EVERYONE around you and it can not be ignored. I personally can say that without the support of family, friends and especially my sorors I don't know how I would have made it this far.

## I am a *Survivor*

I was diagnosed in January 2014 after having a routine mammogram that revealed that I had developed a significant amount of calcification in both of my breasts since the mammogram the year prior. I underwent additional biopsies, ultrasounds and sonograms to confirm the diagnosis. My diagnosis was Ductal Carcinoma in Situ. I had a bilateral mastectomy in May 2014. I was initially a Stage 0/Grade 1; however, during surgery a lymph node was removed from under my armpit. It was tested and found to be positive for malignancy. The positive lymph node increased my Grade to 2-3. As a result I had to undergo chemotherapy (4 months), physical therapy (3 months), radiation (6 weeks) and I am currently on daily hormone therapy medication to end in December 2024.

If not for my faith in God, I truly don't know what my prognosis would have been. My prayer definitely increased and my faith and trust in God soared. Because I knew "whose" I was and "who" was healing me. I was able to maintain a positive attitude which I will always believe was half the battle. I never questioned, "Why me Lord?", because I always knew His response would have been "why not me!"

Although mammography may be uncomfortable, it is a necessary act in life that we must endure. Take it from me, had I not gotten my mammogram when I did, there is no telling what state my cancer would have been once detected. We must prioritize our health! Without it, you can't do anything anyway so why not invest in your physical and mental well-being while you can.

## Race/Ethnicity

White women are slightly more likely to develop breast cancer than African American, Hispanic, and Asian women. But African American women are more likely to develop more aggressive, more advanced-stage breast cancer that is diagnosed at a young age. African American women are also more likely to die from breast cancer. Some of these differences in outcomes may be due to less access to mammography and lower quality medical care, as well as various lifestyle patterns (eating habits and weight issues for example) that are more common in some ethnic groups than in others.

## Obesity

Research has shown that overweight and obese women -- defined as having a BMI (body mass index) higher than 25 -- have a higher risk of being diagnosed with breast cancer compared to women who maintain a healthy weight, especially after menopause. Being overweight also can increase the risk of breast cancer coming back (recurrence) in women who've been diagnosed with the disease.
